The Estes Nonprofit Network created this program in 2022; a total of \$32k in donations has been dispersed so far.

What Organizations Benefit

This program is free to 501(c)(3) nonprofits serving the Estes Valley. In 2024, more than 40 organizations in six different sectors benefited from this program.

Giving Guest Business Partners

Seven Giving Guest Business Partners invite their guests to give back to the Estes Valley in a meaningful way.

How it works for Nonprofits

- *Nonprofits register each December for the next year’s program.*
- *Checks are distributed one time a year, usually in early December.*
- *Nonprofit’s obligations are available during registration.*
